Volunteering at Solidarités Jeunesses



Volunteering is an exchange between a person who offers time, energy, and vision for the benefit of a collective project of general interest. It is also an opportunity to learn, to teach, to experience interculturality and personal construction.



Volunteering is first and foremost a personal commitment. It means being fully involved association's activities, which are multiple, intense and bring different audiences to meet, work and sometimes live together.

Why do we welcome international volunteers? ...

- to allow an intercultural dimension and exchange within all our projects.
- to allow each person evolving within the association to be enriched by the contribution of international volunteers (open-mindedness, self-confidence, discovery of other cultures, learning new languages...)
- to stimulate an alternativ local development by relying on the specific motivation and contributions of international volunteers in our work with local associations and inhabitants of the territory




in the Eastern Local Antenna: Intercultural exchanges & Popular Education in Vosges Alsaciennes

Since October 2021, SJ has been based in the **Bruche Valley** - Vosges Alsaciennes. Ten years ago, we "found" a house in the area that had been bequeathed to us by another association, and the national movement decided to explore the surrounding area to explore possible local opportunities and partnerships. Located 50 km west of Strasbourg, the local branch has organized, with the support of the national and international movement, various actions in 2022 and 2023: workshops to raise awareness of interculturality, international workcamps, youth exchanges, etc. We were each time very well welcomed by the inhabitants which invite us to share their everyday life, as well, they were touched by the active participation of young foreigners in their local general interest projects & interested to know more about all the volunteers coming from all over the world;)



2024 will be our 3rd intercultural funky summer in Alsacian Vosges!

The last 2 years, this international dynamic and interaction with the inhabitants was in a short 2 weeks version. From both sides, it was often too short to deepen the links and to have the time to co-create local events together. That's why, now we know each other more with inhabitants, we decided that was the right « turning point » to experience a longer volunteering version, in order to create oppotunities of intercultural learning & exchanges (more detailed after;).



Collective life

Collective life is the essence of the project. During your time volunteering here, there are around 4 volunteers, 4 international groups (see the details in the table below) and 2 paid-workers who all live together. Everybody is involved collective life : cooking, eating, cleaning, socializing, living in peace and harmony.

Working together

This work has an educational purpose and allows the participants to learn to work together, beyond their social, cultural and linguistic differences. This is also an opportunity to learn more about yourself and to go beyond your limits. You will work about **35 hours per** week, the work is varied and you will get the support of the staff.

Environmental involvment

In our associative project (sort of chart collectively written by the active membres), we claim that « The Solidarités Jeunesses movement works for a more equitable society and values the rich diversity of environments and individuals. It pursues a more sustainable vision of the relationships and interactions between individuals and the environment.»

Concerning environmental involvment, it means that the activities developped within our organization try to be the most respectfull of the environment : food bought with local producers, biological products, less meat (maximum 2 times a week), compost, ... And all the ideas and practices we will have the opportunity to learn from each other this summer;

Socio-cultural Facilitation & intercultural animations


At the same time, taking advantage of our intercultural dynamics, we will organise and coanimate awareness-raising activities on international solidarity and the fight against discrimination, aimed at local people, from all ages. These local intercultural events will take place weekly during the Guinguette in Fouday and also the Café of Belmont, with the local Youth Center of Barembach...

No particular qualification is expected, only the desire to do something together!

If you are willing to improve your facilitator's skills, this experience is a good opportunity! During the on arrival training, we will exchange create differents games collective animations (step by step, moving debat, world café, ...).

So throughout the summer, your role will be to support the different activities organized, according the needs, your skills and the balance in our team.





To be volunteer at SJ is to carry the values of the association through the activities. So to summarize, the missions of the volunteers are very varied:

concerning collective life: it will be about to actively participate to our daily group life and managment of the house & to organize the welcoming, the support and the closure of the 4 differents groups hosted this summer in the hosting center "Louise Scheppler" and being attentive on each other in order it works for everybody. For example, with the support of the team, you will guide and support the differents volunteers to understand better our collective rules about household tasks, organizing together... From the other side, it means that you ar invited to take part to the common activities created by the different groups (international meals, barbecue party, ...).

concerning working together: it will be about organizing the meals (making menus, shopping lists, shopping with local producers, collective cooking, logistics aspects, ...), the hosting, and about co-organizing local intercultural events.

concerning environmental involvment: it will be about supporting all environment practices (shopping, compost, energy, ...) and to pay attention on raising awareness when it is possible or needed.

concerning local intercultural animations : it will be about co-organizing local intercultural events, from logistic preparation to communication (flyers, social networks, ...) and to facilitation of workshops, games, creating international buffet, ... and all the ideas you want to share and co create with us! You will be the ambassadors of our Eastrn Local Antenna, so you will also have the opportunity to promote international volunteering to local youngsters! In brief, foster the link between the project and the inhabitants of the village.

For the different activities, we will have the « before-during-after » principle : for each event we will co-organize together, we will take it as a learning opportunity for each of us to learn from each other and the situation : we will have a meetings process « before-during-after », according our needs and the needs of the project. That is the core of our political project in SJ: that each person finds its place in a group and we are all here to facilitate it and enrich each other.

And concretely, the different summer activities will be the following ones:

During the summer, in the hosting center « Louise Scheppler » & in surrounding villages, we will organise local intercultural events & animations (international meals, intercultural workshops, ...), a weekly Guinguette, 1 international workcamps and 3 European youth exchanges.

One international workcamp in the castle of Salm: for 2 weeks, a group of 12 European volunteers of different nationalities meet to carry out a concrete project of general and local interest.

Three european youth exchanges: 24 young people from different countries, who come to meet and exchange, around a 2-week project, with an educational aim. They organise a series of activities around a theme of common interest in various fields: this year, the 1st one will be around fight against discrimination through theater, 2nd will work about the concept of involvment and the last one will focus on food, from field to the plate.



And also ...

The On arrival training: A 4-days training course will also be offered, designed and run by Martin & Nadège.The aim of this training course is to co-construct the keys to make the volunteering experience a constructive experiment in collective intelligence. It will enable you to know each other better in order to build a complementary team for our common summer, to prepare various workshops for the guinguette and other local animations, ... The training will be fed by the participants, who will share their experiences and skills.


Martin (25)

Hosting Center Louise Scheppler

Le Trouchy 67130 Fouday

The Louise Scheppler House is a collective hosting center so we will sleep in dormitories of 4 - 6 persons. Rooms will be divided between girls and boys. Pillows, undersheets and blankets are provided. You need your sleeping bag. There is a washing machine. There is limited connexion for internet (few hours each day).

One of the objectives of the volunteering is to live together, to share this space with respect for each and everyone. The rules of life of the house are those of the association and of the French legal framework, not debatable (2); and those that you will choose among yourselves (3), according to the needs of each one and in mutual respect. To be involved in the daily life of the group is important, as in a large shared apartment where everyone is responsible for the smooth running of the collective life.

By committing yourself as a volunteer, you are embarking on a unique life experience, discovering yourself and others, learning other languages, discovering or enjoying the pleasure of living in the countryside and having a positive impact on the young and not-so-young people we accompany in their life journey.

The village of Fouday:

Rich in history, Fouday (67130) is a village of 350 inhabitants, situated in the Bruche Valley, at the foot of the Champ du Feu Massif (430m altitude). At the confluence of the river, Chirgoutte, it is an environment of old low mountains, forests and pastures. We are 50 km west of Strasbourg. And the nearest train station is in ... Fouday! The village still has luckily a nice little train station: not so many trains per day but enough to discover the region;)
